Spiritually Speaking

Tests are given to discover where a person is in life, to discover what they have learned, and to discover the strengths and weaknesses they might have. Let me give you a short test. There is no grade. The test is based on honesty. Are you ready? What I want you to do is ask yourself each of these questions, and keep track of how many of them apply to your life.

1. Do you seem to not be at peace with money? Does financial insecurity haunt you?
2. Do you feel like you are always on the outside looking in when it comes to relationships in your life? While others seem to have closeness, warmth, and trust in their relationships, do you feel that you don't?
3. Do you feel like you have had a long series of bad luck? Does life seem to work for other people but not for you?
4. Do you always seem to be at war with someone or something in your life?
5. Are there some things and some behaviors that are beginning to get out of bounds in your life?
6. Does your life seem like an endless series of damage control maneuvers? Are you so busy patching leaks and steering around barriers that you never seem to have a chance to set a meaningful course for your life?

7. Do you always feel vaguely guilty – guilty about things you are doing and guilty about things you should be doing, but aren't?
8. Is your physical health not quite what it should be? Is the way you are treating yourself and your body beginning to take a toll on you?
9. Are you having depression and anxiety in your life a lot more lately?
10. Are you plagued with a strong sense of regret about your life? Do you continually reflect on "if only I had done something different"?
11. Do you look around your home and your possessions and ask, "What's the purpose of it all?"

If you answered yes to several of these questions, then it's time for a reality check in your life. There might be something wrong in some part of your life.

One of the most difficult things we are ever called on to do in life is to be honest with ourselves and honest with God. We don't expect politicians to be honest. We expect them to say whatever it takes to get elected. Honesty seems to be an alien word to our society.

We all have areas in our lives that we need to work on. Not a single one of us is perfect. We all have struggles. We all have questions. We all have difficult times. The first step to self-control, or gaining victory over the weak areas of our lives, is to admit that there are ar-

reas that we have problems in.

It's not easy to be honest with yourself. But honesty is the first step to gaining power over any weakness we find in our lives. We can't fix what we won't admit is broken or in need of repair.

Admitting the issue helps us focus in on what is wrong in our lives, spiritually, financially, emotionally, and physically. God's will is for us to have self-control in our lives.

Second, we need to remember that we have been born into a new life. The life we have in Christ is a powerful life. It doesn't how many weaknesses one discovers in their lives, the power of Christ is stronger than those weaknesses.

Third, we are tested in life to see what we are made of. We experience difficulties and trials to determine where our strengths and weaknesses might be. As each strength and/or weakness is revealed, we have the opportunity to name the problem or the strength. As we name them, we begin to find we have more power to deal with them. When we won't name them, we are failing to recognize that they are present in our world. ▼




