# Spiritually Speaking

[as we had not received Rev. Osdras' column by deadline we are running a spare column Rev. Geisenhainer had submitted last year. Ed.]

Recently, a fellow said to me, "oh, you're such an optimist! You think everything is going to be just great!" As I listened to him I had one of those "aha!" moments, where I realized, No, I am definitely NOT an optimist. But I am hopeful!

An optimist is someone who knows, who just knows for absolutely sure that good things will happen. An optimist knows that they will win the lottery, find a parking space, prevail with a job interview, heck, even bring world peace. They know with certainty that the specific, desired outcome will happen.

But what do we do when "stuff" happens? What can we do when painful things come our way? How can optimism help when we are faced with serious illness, when society seems determined to keep us from living with and loving whom we choose?

One problem with optimism is that it's too brittle; it's not flexible. Optimism demands specific outcomes, focused, precise results. Optimists would say, someday soon, we will have access to the legal right to marry whomever we love. But that goal is so specific, so brittle, and so unrealistic! Optimism, then can lead quickly to pessimism, where we grow morose and expect only the worst things to happen.

For my part, I seek a worldview that is more flexible, more realistic, more in tune with creation and society. I choose hope. First of all, hope is a choice. To be hopeful is to make a conscious choice to be willing to embrace what comes, to find the best in any situation. Next, hope is a willingness. To be hopeful is to be willing to make lemonade when life brings lemons. And hope is resourceful. Those of us who hope embrace what life brings and seek, creatively, to reshape and reform and revise what life brings to make the best possible outcome for all. Hope is a choice. Hope is willingness. And hope is resourceful. And, finally, hope is about relationship; hope is relational.

Those of us schooled and strengthened by the great monotheistic religions, Judaism, Christianity and Islam, have heard the phrase, "with God, all things are possible." The important word

here is "with." Working in concert with God can make the impossible become possible. Working in relationship with God can justify a stance of hope, an assurance that good outcomes can be forged from existing circumstances. Those of us sustained by the non-theistic traditions of the East, or the newer ones of humanism or paganism will recognize, too, that relationship is key. Buddha prayed that we cease to be the cause of suffering to each other. Humanists demand that we roll up our sleeves and do the work of justice with our hands. Pagans teach that we do no harm. All these teachings require relationships, resourcefulness, willingness and choice.

Whatever it is that life brings, good news or bad, we can hope for better times, hope for justice, hope for serenity and peacefulness by working with what is really here and striving to make it better. We can hope, long after optimism has proven naïve and rigid, long after pessimism has frozen us into inaction, we can hope. We don't have to believe that good things will happen. We can choose to make good things come when we work in relationship with one another and with the holy.

Martin Luther King, Jr. encouraged us all to "Keep Hope Alive." Those of us who hope have learned that as long as we connect with one another in love and respect, we can move mountains, we can endure, and we can prevail, we can overcome.

I can't remember where I read this, maybe it was Winnie the Pooh who taught that we should go out "two by two and bring plenty of snacks?" Whoever said it, I think it's great advice. Whether good things or painful things come our way, if we stick together with our friends and loved ones, if we continue to forge alliances with non-gay people who love us and who love justice, if we refuse to debase ourselves with addiction, self-loathing, and self-absorption, we can move forward, day by day, powered by hope, strengthened by love.
