Spiritually Speaking

Remember the song: "It's a Wonderful World?" I suppose it is a wonderful world if you are among those who are on top of the world, from the right side of the tracks. The sad fact is, many people, over the centuries, have been on the wrong side, the wrong color, the wrong gender, the wrong race, the wrong religion, the wrong whatever. By the way, who ever came up with the 'right' or 'wrong' side of things anyway? This is not the wonderful world many envision and sing about.

Gays are still struggling for equal rights and equal rank. Last year the Catholic diocese of Boston announced that it would close its adoption agency rather than conform to Massachusetts law that prohibits discrimination against gays and lesbians. Although nation after nation is extending rightful places to gays, US states are still grappling over gay marriage and the inherent rights of GLBT people. We are viewed suspiciously by religion, politics, and history.

We live on a planet in this 'wonderful world' of ours, where governments routinely arrest, prosecute, and even execute homosexuals. Radical Islamic rulers are not the only ones. The island nation of Jamaica is experiencing outright persecution and murders, the government and religious structures remaining eerily complacent.

Within the gay community, hate crimes are on the rise. Just last month, Ryan Keith Skipper was brutally murdered in Polk county. Stabbed 20 times and his throat cut, this incident reminds us so well we do not live in a wonderful world. Vigils in Ryan's honor were held across Florida. I attended the Lake Worth vigil sponsored by Equality Florida. Those who gathered there April 14th, gathered as a community of like-minded people whose very presence spoke volumes against blatant hatred and murder.

On Tuesday, April 17th, religious leaders from all 50 states assembled in Washington DC to decry discrimination and to speak up for equal rights for gays. This indeed, is the making of history, to have such diverse religious leaders using their clout to preach social justice, namely, agreeing on support of two major pieces of civil rights legislation: a hate crimes bill and a bill banning discrimination in the workplace.

The great social reformer and prophet, Martin Luther King, Jr. said: "Injustice anywhere is a threat

to justice everywhere." Injustice manifests itself from people on the so-called right side oppressing and invalidating people on the perceived wrong side. We do not live in a society of equalities or right standards. And so, we need to hear objective and impartial voices calling us to tolerance, integrity, and fairness.

Jesus Christ surely preached social values that got him into a heap of trouble with the status quo of the Jewish authorities and the Roman occupiers. When he spoke about the poor, the marginalized, the outcast, the persecuted, the perceived 'outsiders', and so many more, Jesus spoke to all people who have borne the hurtful branding of 'unworthy', 'abolished', and 'disowned'. The social principles of Jesus are admired by Christians and non-Christians alike. Jesus stood up and spoke out, as we should. True spirituality implies more than mere rhetoric and demands assertive action. It is high time we lift our voices and put our faith into action as great men and women of the past have exemplified and great ones of the present continue to do, regardless of the cost.

Although, we in the gay community feel the struggle many other groups have had to grapple with, we need to be careful not to forget those for whom the full meaning of justice entail. Recently, Comedienne Roseanne Bar, who has a long history of being supportive of GLBT issues, accused gays of being too self absorbed. Although she later apologized for her remarks, and many have accepted her apology, it is advisable to take the comment of self-absorption to heart.


I believe that as we, the gay community, stand up and speak out for social justice—everywhere—and not just for our own backyard, we shall advance the 'cause' more rapidly. Then, perhaps, that elusive and utopian wonderful world shall shine in all its budding promise of wonder and strength. ▼
